SCA Annual Membership and Election Meeting in August By-Laws Amendments to be Discussed

Our Annual Membership and Election meeting will take place on August 20, 2000, at 3:00 p.m. at Selby Beach. If you are a member of the Selby Community Association (SCA) and a lot owner, this will be your opportunity to vote or run for a position on the Board of Directors. Nominations will be accepted from the floor.

Amendments to our Constitution and By-laws have been proposed. The proposed amendments will be read at this meeting, but they will not be voted on until October 1, 2000. They must "sit on the table until the next regular meeting" before being acted on. If the amendments are adopted, all lot owners will be members and dues will no longer be required. Revenue will be provided through the Special Benefit District and through donations. Copies of the proposed amendments will be available at the August 20, 2000, meeting.

Clubhouse Parking Lot: If you are planning to have a party in the clubhouse or on the beach, and your guests will be parking in the clubhouse parking lot, you must tell Dennis Gheen (contact information is at the end of the newsletter), so he can give you temporary parking passes for your guests. Any car without a parking sticker or pass will be towed.

Boat Ramp: It is a violation to lend your boat ramp key to anyone who has not paid for one. If you do, you will lose your right to use the ramp. All vehicles parked at the boat ramp must have parking stickers or they will be towed. Please do not park in the turn-around circle because it blocks others.

Editorial Corner

The county may have determined that our community does not qualify for speed humps, but this decision does not mean we still don't have a problem with cars speeding through our neighborhood. The potential for disaster grows as the number of new families in Selby increases. Other communities with similar problems have set up citizen radar patrols backed by the police, but these are targeted at pass through traffic.

Speeders here are us, our neighbors, and our friends. They are not just the teenager from down the street; they are parents with children as well. The county can only do so much to control our driving behavior. In a community without sidewalks such as ours, it is imperative that we drive with extreme caution. It is just as important that as pedestrians and bicyclists, we obey the rules of the road as well. When walking or jogging, stay to the left of the road to face oncoming traffic. When

bicycling, obey all traffic rules as if you were driving a car (stay to the right, stop at stop signs). Be sure your children know these rules when they go out to play. We will not gain substantial time no matter how late we are by speeding, and no matter how quick you may think your driving reflexes are, children and dogs are quicker. When you make the turn into Selby, for all of our sakes, slow down and relax--you're almost home.

Beach and Clubhouse:


