## **New Building Moratorium in Selby Heights**

Currently, an area of Selby served by the sewer pump station on Holly Ave. is now closed to new development until the County can upgrade the pump station to allow more capacity. Selby Heights is now in the same situation. The pump station is located on 8<sup>th</sup> Ave. The moratorium includes most properties west of Hillside Ave. and south of Fontron Dr. Both moratoriums are temporary, but there is no date set at this time as to when the moratoriums will be lifted.


