YDF's Motion to Appeal Denied

We are one giant step closer to finalizing the clubhouse lawsuit. Judge Silkworth ruled that Youth Development Foundation (YDF) cannot proceed with their incorrectly filed appeal of the Court's earlier decision granting our Motion for Summary Judgment (MSJ). We filed a motion asking that the appeal be dismissed on the grounds that they did not follow the proper procedures. They then filed a motion asking to amend their appeal so that it could be heard. The Courts have strict policies regarding how appeals are to be filed, so their motion was denied. YDF has not yet responded to this new ruling. The Mayo Water Reclamation Facility (MWRF) is scheduled to be upgraded next Spring to increase capacity and to improve the quality of the effluent. An informational public hearing will take place on **Tuesday, November 6, 2001, at Central Middle School's Activity Center from 7:00 to 8:00 p.m.** This meeting will be an opportunity to view plans and speak with project managers and engineers. The MWRF is located between Selby and Loch Haven. Treated effluent from the facility is discharged into the Rhode River near its mouth.
