## STILL WAITING PATIENTLY...

After reconsideration of an earlier decision, the Circuit Court of Anne Arundel County allowed YDF to appeal last May's decision, in our favor, of our Motion for Summary Judgment, which upheld the 1932 Injunction on the clubhouse. The appeal hearing before the Court of Special Appeals took place on February 11, 2002. Only our attorney was permitted to be present at this hearing. The Court's decision will most likely be rendered sometime this summer. If the appeal is denied, we maintain all the rights we gained in the upholding of the injunction. While this decision is pending, we are still using the clubhouse for the benefit of the community.



### Hippity Hoppity, Easter's on Its Way

The Selby Community Association's annual Easter Celebration will be held at the Beach on Saturday, March 30, 2002, from 12:00 Noon until 3:00 p.m. Activities include the following.

### Community Clean-Up Day

Once again, it's time to clean up our streets, marshes, and beach! Community Clean Up day is scheduled for Saturday, April 13, 2002. Anyone can participate. Meet at the clubhouse to get trash bag(s) between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m. or use your own. Clean up anywhere in Selby you wish and leave the bag on the side of the road by 3 p.m. Crews will collect the bags, and all of the refuse will be taken away. Refreshments will be provided at the clubhouse. Volunteers are always needed to pitch in with cleaning the areas around the beach and clubhouse. This clean up day is only for common areas and items such as brush and roadside trash.

Disposal of large household and yard items can be done in August when the County will provide

dumpsters to the community for that purpose. For more information, call Mitch Boyd at 410-798-5548.




### April Showers Bring... Ouch!

It's Spring--time to enjoy the flowers, the fresh air, and the painful bite of the tiger mosquito. Unfortunately, these pests do not confine their attacks to dusk, but will bite at any time of the day, making them not only annoying, but also more difficult to avoid. Once again this year, tiger mosquitoes are expected to be a major problem in our area. Because these mosquitoes in their lifetime do not travel further than your or your neighbor's yard, they can be controlled.

To prevent these pests from breeding, there are some simple steps to take. Tiger mosquitoes can breed in as little standing water as is in a soda cap, flower pot overflow dish, or small puddle. Keep them out of your yard by cleaning your rain gutters to allow rain to flow freely, storing any containers in your yard upside down (including flower pots, kiddie pools, pet dishes, wheelbarrows, or buckets), emptying trapped water in tarps over boats or pools and arranging the tarp to drain water, fixing dripping outside faucets, and replacing water in birdbaths or ornamental ponds at least twice a week. If there is standing water in drainage ditches in the community, contact the County to have them cleared so that they drain freely. A product called, "mosquito dunks" can also be used in certain situations to minimize breeding.

To keep these and other mosquitoes from biting (or at least reduce the number of bites), use insect repellents on your body and clothing. Keeping these pests to a minimum in our community can be done if we can each do our small part.
